Term 2 Classes

In the second term at In2Learning Wanaka we'll offer classes on Mondays as well as Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. All sessions run from 3.30 to 4.50, 5.00 to 6.20 and 6.30 to 7.50.

Catch-ups

We are happy to provide a catch-up lesson where a student is sick provided, we are notified prior to the lesson. (Please notify us by 10am).

If the student is away for any other reason, we can offer catch-up sessions if we are notified of non-attendance 24 hours in advance (emergencies excluded of course). The catch-up time may not be the best and is dependent on availability.

Catch-ups aren't held over to the following term, unless the student was sick during the last week of the term.
